But as the days shorten and the fall shadows lengthen, let us look back at some of the things your BLPOA Executive has been doing on your behalf. Most importantly, our Water Testing Program continues to be a service of which we are very proud. Thank you to Judy Dunn and Bill Paterson who have diligently monitored the health of our lake for many years. Again this year, we were able to secure a \$1000.00 grant from Perry Township to help with water testing costs.

Last September we ended the "summer season" with our annual Corn Roast. Thank you to Wayne and Kathy Cook who have co-hosted this event along with the Association for several years. It is always a great evening of fun and friendship.

This year we obtained a licence from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry to stock fish in Bay Lake. This will breathe new life into the Fish Fund, to which people have been faithfully donating for many years. The licence allows us to stock up to 10 000 pickerel fingerlings per year for 3 years.

There is a new "lake depth" sign down at the boat ramp. If you haven't seen it, be sure to check it out when you take your boat out of the lake this fall. "Place Mat" style replicas of this map can be purchased from the Association.

We had another very successful Pancake Breakfast and Silent Auction this year, on the May long weekend. Over 200 breakfasts were served! And nobody went away hungry. There were also some great bargains in the Silent Auction, which raised almost \$1400.00 in support of your Association. The Executive offers a sincere "thank you" to all those generous individuals who donated items to the auction. Congratulations to Rob Tilley, the luck winner of the 50-50 draw. This annual event is a wonderful opportunity to meet old and new friends as we head into the summer season on Bay Lake.

This year, with each 2016-2017 membership, you received an Appreciation Plaque. We hope you will display this plaque proudly in recognition of your valuable support of the Association

Back in April, about eighteen hearty individuals set out on the roadways around Bay Lake for our annual Pitch-In Day clean up. Many bags of re-cycleables and garbage were collected. Thank you to Bill Paterson who has organized this event for many years.

Transfer Station Attendant: proof of residence is required by

either driver's license or a utility bill. Each household is permitted to dispose of an allotted 5 bags of refuse per month. A charge of \$2.00 for each bag to be disposed of over and above the 5 bag

limit shall apply. A bag of refuse can be no larger than 26'' by 36''. Carry-over of bags from one month to another is not permitted (bags must be used within the allotted month on the disposal card).
